

## Chewton Town Hall

The judges felt that the Chewton Town Hall restoration project is an outstanding project that has conserved the significance and ensured the longevity of this important place. The high quality conservation works by Period Building Conservation followed the best practice approach of ‘changing as much as necessary but as little as possible’ and included: the repair and re-render of masonry walls, foundations and chimneys, the removal of the non-original concrete floor and replacement with floorboards, mitigating and repairing termite damage and rising damp in walls. The building facilities were also upgraded as part of the project in order to provide the many elements required to bring this important community asset back to life. The whole project was funded by grant and donation and managed by a community committee, the Chewton Domain Society.
